"Can I check for conflicts against my email in Amicus Attorney?"

Absolutely! With the Amicus Attorney conflict check, you can optionally include all communication records - both inbound and outbound. If you save your practice related emails to their corresponding Amicus Attorney file or contact, the conflict check will search all of those messages to make sure that nothing is missed. All emails saved in Amicus will be searched, even those sent to or from other firm members!

Any potential conflicts will be displayed in the conflict check results report along with the name of the firm member associated to the email in question.
