NOTES

Firewall: Firewalls should not prevent the server from being accessible/visible to workstations. If you are running a firewall on the Server, ensure that you configure it to unblock the File and Printer Sharing service.

Microsoft Windows Vista: Amicus Attorney works on Windows Vista with some exceptions, as noted in the Windows Vista Compatibility Statement available from the Support > Technical Resource Guides page on our website. Note that Processor and RAM requirements for Vista are considerably higher than those specified in this document for Amicus. Windows Vista Business Edition is recommended.

Microsoft Windows XP Home Edition: XP Home Edition is quite suitable for Amicus Attorney in a single-user environment with all of the Amicus Attorney files resident on the user's workstation, and for Amicus Attorney Secondary Office workstations. However, the Windows XP Home Edition operating system is designed for the home user. It lacks many of the networking and security capabilities of Windows XP Professional or 2000 and may not be appropriate in a multi-user business setting. Specifically, an XP Home system cannot join a domain and cannot manage more than five concurrent file sharing connections. We do not recommend XP Home Edition for use on the server used for your Amicus Attorney. XP Home Edition will also add additional challenges to an Amicus workstation in a networked environment. Specifically, a user using Amicus would need to reestablish the mapped drive to the server on each Windows startup.

If running Microsoft Windows XP with multiple individuals sharing the same workstation in a standalone or workgroup environment: Amicus Attorney maintains a local database for maximum performance. Consequently, only one Amicus Attorney office is supported on a single workstation. Before starting Amicus Attorney, you should ensure that the logged in person matches the Amicus Attorney Team Member for that workstation. If other individuals sharing the workstation launch Amicus Attorney while they are logged in, they will be opening that Team Member's Office and not their own. Ensuring that the logged in individual matches the Team Member is especially important for proper data exchange and synchronization with third party link applications (i.e., Outlook, e-mail, etc.).

Workstation Network Card: Amicus Attorney passes a tremendous amount of information back and forth over the network. Far more data is communicated than that used by typical word processing, accounting, or e-mail applications that a firm may have used in the past. As a result, Amicus Attorney Small Firm Edition is more exposed to any weaknesses in a firm's network structure than other programs might be. One common cause of network problems is cheap network cards, which can randomly cause data corruption. We highly recommend that you have good quality network cards in every workstation.

Other Applications: The requirements in this document are for running Amicus Attorney. If running additional applications at the same time, ensure that the computer has sufficient resources for those other applications as well.

PDF Documents: Adobe Acrobat Reader 5.0 or higher (or equivalent) is needed for reading PDF format documents.
