Running the Amicus Server as a Service on your Network Server

If you wish to run the Amicus Server program (AMICUSSERVER.EXE) as a Service on your network server, you must have installed the Client/Server Edition of Amicus Attorney Version 5.0.2 or higher in a Windows 2000 or higher environment.

In addition, you must have performed a Split Install of Amicus Attorney. This installs Amicus Administrator and the Team Database separately, typically with Amicus Administrator on a workstation, and with the Team Database files and Amicus Server program on your network server. (If you did a Embedded Install and then attempted to run the Amicus Server program as a service, you would not be able to start Amicus Administrator.)

WARNING: Once you are running the Amicus Server as a service, DO NOT run the Amicus Server as a program, as doing so will sever the connection between the Amicus Server and the Team Member workstations.

Please ensure that the Network Administrator performs the following steps.

Confirm that following four files reside in the ...\\TEAM50\\Extras folder:

- RunAAasService.bat
- AAserver.reg
- INSTSRV.EXE
- SRVANY.EXE

If the TEAM50 folder was installed in a location other than C:\\Program Files, you must manually modify the RunAAasService.bat and AAserver.reg files as follows:

- 1 Open Windows Explorer and browse to the ...\\TEAM50\\Extras folder.
- 2 Ensure that RunAAasService.bat and AAserver.reg are not set to Read Only.
- 3 From the ...\\TEAM50\\Extras folder, right-click on the RunAAasService.bat file and select Edit.
- 4 From Notepad, replace the file path text (as highlighted in the graphic below) with the file path text that indicates where you installed the TEAM50 folder (e.g., D:\\Amicus Attorney\\Installation).

regedit /s "c:\Program Files\Team50\Extras\AAserver.reg"
::where again c:\Program Files\Team50\ should be replaced with the actual location of the Team
database

:: you may now start the service manually using the control panel or
net start AmicusServer

IMPORTANT: Please ensure that you have entered the correct path of where your TEAM50 folder has been installed. Otherwise, incorrect information will be entered into the registry when you run the RunAAasService.bat file.

- 5 Select File > Save and exit from Notepad.
- 6 From the ...\\TEAM50\\Extras folder, right-click on the AAserver.reg file and select Edit.
- 7 From Notepad, replace the file path text (as highlighted in the graphic below) with the file path text that indicates where you installed the TEAM50 folder (e.g., D:\\Amicus Attorney\\Installation). Please ensure that you insert double slashes as parameters.

IMPORTANT: Please ensure that you have entered the correct path of where your TEAM50 folder has been installed. Otherwise, incorrect information will be entered into the registry when you run the RunAAasService.bat file.

- 8 Select File > Save and exit from Notepad.
- 9 Run the RunAAasService.bat file by right clicking on the file and selecting Open. This will make the necessary changes to your Registry and will run the Amicus Server as a service (and will start it automatically by default).
