Outlook Synchronization

This optional bi-directional synchronization with Microsoft Outlook aligns the information contained in your Contacts, Appointments, and Tasks/To Do's in both applications. Once enabled, the synchronization is completely dynamic. When you add, modify, or delete a record in Amicus Attorney, it will appear or disappear automatically in Outlook, and vice-versa. You can configure this feature to exchange any combination of Contacts, Appointments, and Tasks/To Do's in either direction or in both directions.

Outlook Contacts & Calendar Synchronization is an ideal vehicle for migrating your data into Amicus Attorney, for large firms where all members use Microsoft Outlook but not all members use Amicus Attorney, or for firms where employees make frequent use of Personal Digital Assistants (PDAs).

Issue 14288: When Time Entries were posted from Amicus Attorney to Amicus Accounting, only the first 255 characters of the Description were included. *Fixed.*
